On May 1, PHC opened its new satellite women's clinic in Berea. The clinic is open on Wednesdays and Thursdays, offering pregnancy testing and ultrasounds. This gives PHC the ability to more effectively serve the southern end of the county and beyond. Donna Proctor, who had been serving as a nurse at the Richmond location for over two years, is now the nurse on staff in Berea. She is joined by Brooke Barrett as the client advocate.

Nearly a dozen patient visits have already taken place in the first month.
