

During the ultrasound, Cara pointed and smiled at the screen, even saying, "Hello, kid" as the baby appeared. As it continued, she and Evan talked about the heartbeat and pondered what the baby would like, each sharing that they hoped for a boy.

support women who are facing those difficult decisions. He encouraged us to be "all in" when it comes to supporting LIFE!


Founder Kathy Todd awarded the annual Founder's Award to Attorney General Daniel Cameron for his continued stand for protecting the life of unborn children.

### **THRIVE launches in local schools**

PHC's sexual risk avoidance programming, known as THRIVE, launched in local schools this Fall. With the instruction of an evidence-based curriculum known as "Relationships Under Construction," the teaching team presented to more than 300 students at two middle schools and two high schools. Here is what some of the students had to say:

#### "THE TRUTHFULNESS. PEOPLE" NEED TO HEAR THIS."

"Learned how to properly love someone without bringing sex into it."

"Teaches us what is better for us and how to stay safe." "It really opened my eyes to how many risks there are."

"Learning about things that my parents won't talk to me about."

# PHC's Annual Ministry Impact (through November)

- Our medical clinic has seen a 33% increase in visits from 2022 with 206 clinic visits. We have conducted 138 pregnancy tests and 137 ultrasounds. We confirmed that 15 women who came in thinking abortion was their only option changed their mind after seeing their ultrasound and CHOSE LIFE!
- Client mentors have conducted 423 client visits with women in our Earn While You Learn parenting program.
- Our fatherhood mentors had 40 client visits.
- We had 41 client visits with women in our Step Up parent program (for court-ordered clients) and celebrated as four individuals completed and graduated from the program.
- We were able to purchase 10 NEW car seats for women who completed our Car Seat Incentive Program.
- We have welcomed 16 babies to clients enrolled in our parenting programs.
- We provided 57 instances of material aid for those in need of emergency assistance of diapers and/or formula.
- Volunteers contributed 753 hours of service to PHC with their dedication and servant hearts!

## Two-day Golf for Life event a wonderful success!

Due to the increasing popularity, PHC expanded the Golf Fore Life to be a two-day event with 40 teams participating at Battlefield Golf Course. Over \$25,000 was raised to support the ongoing mission of PHC. Much of the scramble's continued success is owed to Ricky Clontz and Jeff Mounts, both of whom devote countless hours to planning for and assisting with the event.
